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Dear Parents

This is the last Headmistress's letter of the academic year. Last week we have had an excellent Moving Up Day when pupils enjoyed spending time with their teachers for next year. Year 5 thoroughly enjoyed their 'taster day' as Year 6 pupils, as did the new Year 7 senior pupils, meeting teachers, having some taster senior lessons and getting to know each other in team building activities. It was a super day and lovely to meet our new pupils on the junior and senior sites.

# Early Years Celebration on Friday 7 July at 1.30pm

The Kindergarten and Reception children have been preparing for their End of Year Celebration, which takes place on Friday at 1.30pm in the marquee on the senior site. Parents should go straight to the seniors and the Early Years staff will be bringing the children to the marquee.

I am looking forward to presenting the children with their certificates of achievement after another very successful year for our youngest pupils.

Every pupil in Reception is either exceeding or has met every one of the areas of learning in the Early Years framework. This is a wonderful achievement for all of the children.
