# **Braeside Headship Announcement**

When we returned to school last week, Mr Hagger shared with parents and staff future plans for Braeside and for the Oak-Tree Group. He explained that my role will be developing over the next two years so that rather than being the Headmistress of two of the four schools, I will become a Principal of all four schools from September 2019.

It has been my pleasure and privilege to work closely with the staff and pupils at Braeside, as well as their families, over the last three years and to lead the school through many positive developments over that time.

The changes coincide with me becoming Chair of the Independent Schools Association, which is the body to which our schools belong. There are over 500 schools in ISA membership and many of the events, competitions and opportunities we give our pupils arise from our membership of this charitable body, of which I have been an Executive Officer and Trustee for a number of years.

I am delighted that Mrs Moon will become Headmistress from September. Many of you know her very well already and you will know first-hand her commitment to the girls and to the education we offer here at Braeside. I know she has received a number of lovely messages to congratulate her on her new role from parents and staff, and I am sure she will be excellent.

As you would expect, she and I will be spending time this term and in the summer break to ensure a smooth and thorough handover. I will be talking to the pupils about the changes in assemblies over the forthcoming week.

# **GCSE Examinations**

The staff and I are pleased to see the focused and mature frame of mind in which Year 11 has returned to school following the Easter break. The GCSE exams begin next week, with practical art and speaking exams, before the written papers commence on Monday 13 May.

I hope our pupils feel well-prepared and positive as their exams start. I wish them all the very best; the staff are behind them and I look forward to sharing the good news of their results in August.

# **Year 10 Apprentice Prefects**

As Year 11 begin their study leave, Year 10 will be invited to apply to become prefects next year. They will have interviews and become apprentice prefects, in advance of the announcement of the new Prefect Team as usual at Speech Day.

## ISA Regional Athletics Tuesday 14 May

The ISA regional athletics competition this year takes place in Bedford on Tuesday 14 May. As usual the PE department will be taking some pupils to represent the school in Bedford. This is an important athletics meeting, with hundreds of competitors. There are over nearly 100 ISA schools in our region, in fact we are the largest region nationally, so this gives our pupils the opportunity to compete in a large venue with pupils from many other independent schools.

Last year, as in previous years, the Oak-Tree Schools won a good number of regional gold medals, which meant that those individual competitors or teams represented the region, and our school, in the prestigious national ISA National Athletics Competition in Birmingham in June at the Alexander Stadium. Over the years we have had many pupils selected for Nationals, which is an excellent achievement. Once again this year I will be presenting medals at the event, so I am looking forward to the chance of presenting a medal to one of our own pupils.

## Sports Day Thursday 20 June

Sports Day takes place towards the end of the summer term this year at the Lee Valley Athletics track for all classes from Kindergarten up to Year 10. All parents are welcome to join us for the event at Lee Valley from 12pm. The schedule will be very similar to last year, which parents really enjoyed. The pupils will compete in their Houses and the junior and senior sports awards will be presented.

Pupils come to school in their sports kit on the day, including tracksuit. Parents who attend may take their children home directly from the track at the end of the afternoon; alternatively, pupils return to school by coach and can be collected from school or from After School Club.

## Years 7-10 End of Year Examinations

Senior school summer exams are in the week after half-term. During this week normal lessons are suspended and pupils have their exams instead. These assessments form an important part of our monitoring of pupil progress over the course of the year. Parents and pupils will shortly receive a copy of the exam timetable. Please encourage your daughters to revise thoroughly for these assessments, which review the whole year's learning. Pupils are being advised on revision techniques in form time and with their subject teachers, and teachers will be directing pupils towards what they should revise.

## **Junior End of Year Examinations**

Junior pupils also have their assessments taking place this term and Mrs Copeman, the Head of Juniors, will be providing parents with details of the assessments, which take place before the half-term break. All the assessments are to help us evaluate the progress each individual child has made over the course of the year.

## **Clubs from September**

We will be finalising the Extra-curricular clubs list for September and parents will receive a copy of the schedule at half-term. There is a range of activities for pupils to select in the autumn term and I hope they enjoy the choices on offer.
