# **GCSE Mock Exams again**

Year 11 pupils should have used the feedback from their last round of mock exams to direct their revision over the break. The next round of exams comes around very soon after the February Half Term Break. Please encourage your daughter to revise as well as completing homework. Every pupil in Year 11 has different targets to improve on their results. It would be helpful to your daughter if you could discuss their personalised targets with them to reinforce this.

#### Reports

You should have received a report published to the portal at the end of the term. If you have any questions about the reports once they have been published, please email the teacher directly for the most effective response. The report reflects your child's current 'working at' grade or level and targets for improvement. It is important that you discuss your child's report with them so that they are clear about their personal targets and how to achieve them over the forthcoming term.

## **PE news**

From January, Kindergarten PE days will be Tuesdays and Thursdays and Year 3 PE days will be Mondays and Fridays.

In their double PE lessons this half term, Years 7-9 will be travelling by minibus to Old Loughts Hockey Club. Your daughter will need a hockey stick, shin pads and a gum shield. They will not be able to take part in the lesson without these. Astro trainers are also recommended. Please note that the length of the hockey stick should come up to your daughters' hip.

I am incredibly pleased that Year 10 and 11 will be attending Science Live on 24 January as this event is run by the exam board and examiners to support students in answering exam questions effectively in the forthcoming GCSE exams. Please do ask your daughter about the day after they have returned home so that they can synthesise the information.

Year 2 and 3 will be attending an experience day in London on 29 January. Many of our students have watched the Paddington Bear series of films and read the stories by Michael Bond. These stories are classics and we will be sharing these with students in the lead up to the event.

We have two music concerts for pupils who take peripatetic music lessons in guitar, piano, violin and singing. The Junior concert is on 17 January in the afternoon and the Senior one is on 31 January. I do hope to see you support your child in their musical endeavours as it is always a wonderful afternoon of music.

We have various sporting events from tag rugby, netball and House Cross Country. Rugby events are likely to be muddy so please supply your child with spare kit / uniform so that they feel comfortable after the event. These communications will be emailed to you in advance of the event.
